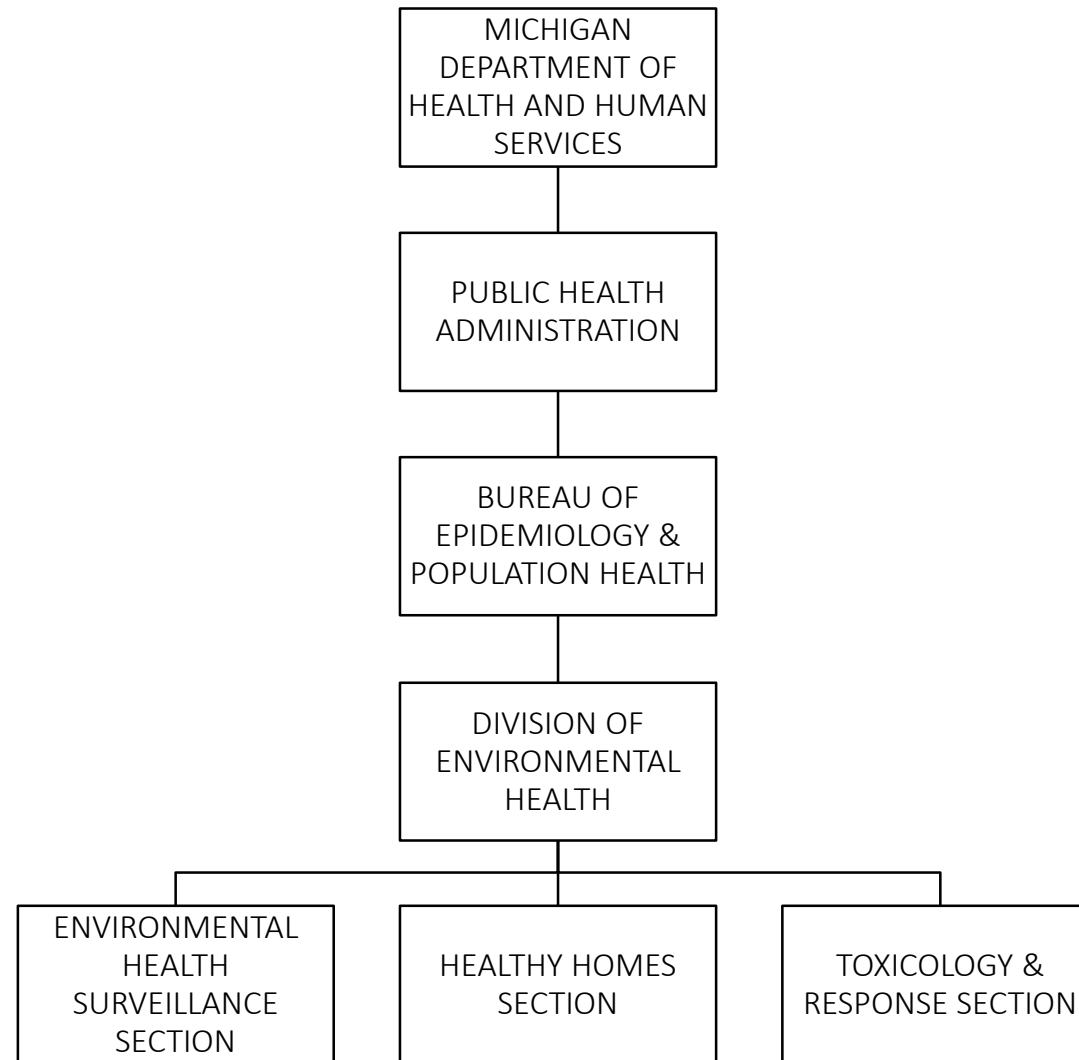

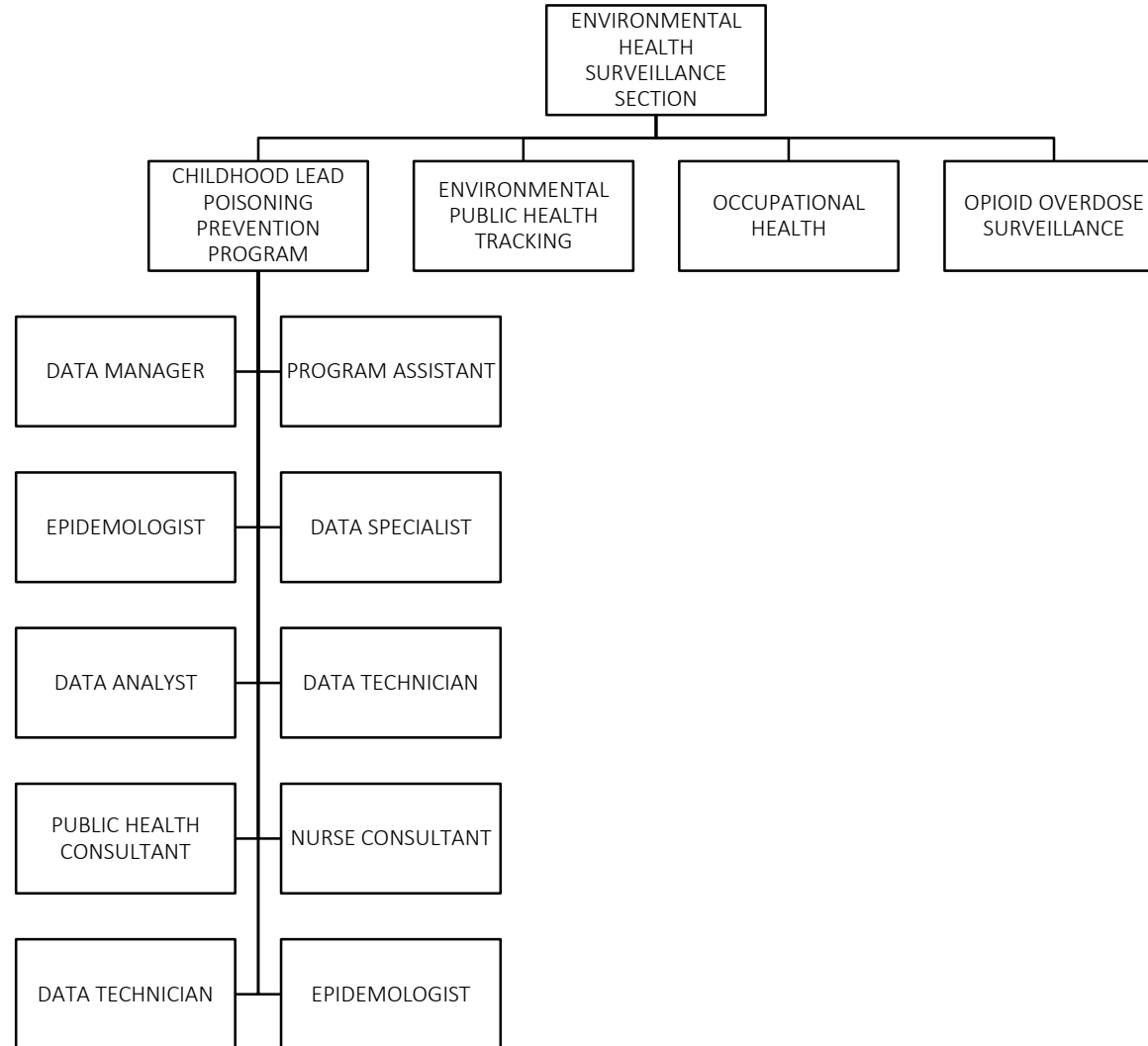
CLPPP Mission and Vision

- Mission: To prevent childhood lead poisoning across the state through surveillance, outreach, and health services
- Vision: No child in Michigan suffers from lead poisoning

Michigan's Title V MCH Program

- supports a wide range of critical MCH programs and services across the state
- overarching goal is to improve the health and well-being of the state's mothers, infants, children, and adolescents
- state priority needs are determined by a five-year needs assessment (most recent one completed in 2015)

Michigan's Title V Block Grant

State Priority Need: Foster safer homes, schools, and environments with a focus on prevention.

Objectives: Increase from baseline the percent of all children under age 6 with an elevated blood lead level from a capillary test who receive a venous lead confirmation test.

State Performance Measure: Percent of children less than 72 months of age who receive a venous lead confirmation testing within 30 days of an initial positive capillary test.
