 - Submit all documentation (FSR, Spreadsheet, FSR Supplemental Form), even if 0 home visits were completed for the quarter
 - Ensure that the Plan of Care and Assessment are uploaded in HHLPSS
 - Ensure that the child has a venous confirmatory test
 - Verify in CHAMPS that the child is Medicaid eligible at the time of the home visit

 - Question: Are decimals coming? They are coming, but pending approval of how they will be handled. More communication will come on this as CLPPP gets closer to implementing the new database, MiCLPS.
