2. MDHHS CLPPP Mission and Vision
  - Mission – to prevent childhood lead poisoning across the state through surveillance, outreach, and health services.
  - Vision – no child in Michigan suffers from lead poisoning.
  - Everything we do going forward will align with our mission and vision.
3. FY18 Quarterly Reimbursement Submissions
  - FY17 #s – quarter 2: 262 visits, quarter 3: 337 visits, quarter 4: 371 visits (total of 970 visits) Compared to 2,938 claims/encounters between 6/1/2006 and 12/31/2016 for <=18 years of age at least one day after a beneficiary had a blood lead test of >=5. (This was using a specific code of T1028 so, if it was billed under a different procedure code it wouldn't be included in this number.)
  - Quarter 1 (October 1 – December 31, 2017) **Due January 30**
  - Quarter 2 (January 1 – March 31, 2018) **Due April 30**
  - Reminders when submitting spreadsheets:
    - Indicate if children are siblings receiving EBL NCM
    - Submit all documentation (FSR, FSR supplemental form, spreadsheet)
    - If 0 hrs were completed for the quarter, submit a FSR supplemental form indicating that or send Angela an e-mail
    - Ensure that plans of care and assessments are uploaded into HHLPSS
      - This is verified by CLPPP. LHD's staff may receive emails if documentation is missing from HHLPSS.
    - Ensure that the child had a venous confirmatory test
      - This is required for reimbursement.
    - Ensure that child is Medicaid eligible at the time of the home visit through CHAMPS
4. Rounding of Test Results
  - The rounding decision has been escalated to MDHHS Administration to make a final decision. Once it has been made and is in writing it will be sent out to LHD's.
5. HHLPSS
  - Preferred Method of Learning

- Login Requirements
  - CLPPP is required to keep an updated HHLPPS list of active and inactive users. We recently went through the user list and deleted 90 people that no longer needed access and disabled 67 that did not log into HHLPPS by Feb 2<sup>nd</sup> or did not respond to our correspondence. Going forward every user should **log in on a monthly** basis. We will be tracking each users log in dates and we will be deactivating accounts if the user hasn't logged in for 3 consecutive months. If your account is deactivated, you will be required to take quiz reactivate your account. To reactivate your account contact Veronica.
  - Cases are now opening at 5 cap or venous.
- 6. MCIR Lead Tab
  - Should be working properly, updates went into effect beginning of February. Contact Jessica Cooper ([cooperj3@michigan.gov](mailto:cooperj3@michigan.gov)), if there are any children that are still missing the lead tab or any tests that are missing from the tab.
  - Tests from previous years should also be showing.
- 7. Child Lead Exposure Elimination Commission
  - RFP
    - The Commission will select up to 10 projects of up to \$75,000 for projects that demonstrate innovative approaches to the elimination of child lead exposure and have the potential to be replicated throughout the state. They are expected to be based on science and best practices and show demonstrable results within one year. Grant funds are for new projects and not available to continue or sustain current programs. Questions on this must be submitted in writing by today and applications are due by 3/15 at 12 p.m. to Kristin Benson ([bensonk5@michigan.gov](mailto:bensonk5@michigan.gov)). Application posted on MDHHS procurement website also is in the press release that was sent out last week.
