1. Welcome and Introductions
2. FDA Safety Warning
 - A document containing a list of individuals within jurisdictions that meet CDC recommended criteria for retesting has been uploaded to LHD FTP site
 - List is available to LHDs for informational purposes, CLPPP is not asking for LHDs to follow up on these children directly. CLPPP is working with Medicaid and MCIR to provide these lists to the providers, to provide follow up and talk to their patients about re-testing.
 - A detailed e-mail explain this will be sent out next week along with a Q and A document that summarizes the CDC recommendations to the FDA safety warning and MDHHS response
 - Questions on this should be directed to RoseAnn Miller, our lead epidemiologist at MDHHS-LeadCare@michigan.gov
3. Care Coordination Agreements with Medicaid Health Plans
 - Latest is that Medicaid is finalizing and will have the final version to CLPPP by Monday 6/19. CLPPP will send an e-mail out with this final version next week. LHDs will have about 60 days to work with the MHPs to get signatures and have copies e-mailed to Angela at medinaa@michigan.gov.
4. Quarter 2 Reimbursement
 - Around 270 HVs completed statewide
5. Reminders
 - Quarter 3 Reimbursement – Due July 30th, 2017
 - i. Indicate if children are siblings
 - ii. Submit all documentation (FSR, Spreadsheet, FSR Supplemental Form), even if 0 home visits were completed for the quarter
 - iii. Ensure that the Plan of Care and Assessment are uploaded in HHLPSS
 - iv. Ensure that the child has a venous confirmatory test
 - v. Verify in CHAMPS that the child is Medicaid eligible at the time of the home visit
 - Trainings/SharePoint
 - i. Available for LHD use
 - ii. Karen and Jane Nickert are doing a training roadshow by prosperity region. Majority have already taken place or are scheduled. If a LHD has not been contacted about this training, please contact Karen
 - iii. If there are specific topics or cases that LHDs would like incorporated into the training, let Karen know.

- i. E-mails on the CCA, LeadCare, and notes from this call will be sent out in the next couple weeks. If there is anyone within the LHD that needs to be on the listserv, let Angela know.
 - Monthly Fee-For-Service Reports
 - i. Sent out at the end of each month, posted on FTP site. Report of children in each jurisdiction that are enrolled in FFS for that month. Those children are aged 10 months to 3 years.
- 6. Roll Call –
 - How does your LHD use the monthly Fee-For-Service Reports sent from MDHHS CLPPP?
 - i. LHDs use them to identify kids who need testing, follow up, use the report in conjunction with other reports, send letters to those who are due for a blood lead test
 - ii. Many LHDs indicated that they do not use the monthly FFS report but will look into this as a way to increase lead testing in their county for Medicaid kids
 - Lessons learned:
 - i. Verify address for every contact that is made with child/family because there is constant relocation
 - Questions for MDHHS CLPPP (Angela will follow-up on the below questions and clarify in e-mail via govdelivery)
 - i. HVs – 6 per year or per lifetime?
 - ii. HVs – 6 limit, even if child moves to a new jurisdiction?
