3. FY18 Quarterly Reimbursement Submissions

6. In-person Training – September 11, 2018 – Sent out Save-the-Date e-mail. The training will be 9:30-3:30 in the South Grand Building in Lansing. More information will be sent on in regards to a final agenda and registration this summer. Our keynote speaker will be Dr Bhambhani, who runs the lead clinic at Children’s Hospital. She will be speaking about chelation. There will also be a data presentation, HHL PSS training, practice scenarios, and HHS/CLPPP protocol refreshers.
7. Toolkits – CLPPP working on developing a new toolkit with education materials targeting different audiences, such as landlords/tenants, parents, and providers. They will be distributed at the September in-person meeting, and available in an electronic version.
8. HHL PSS
 - a. Training - sending out survey by the end of the week to gauge Mi-HHL PSS user’s wants and needs for HHL PSS training. All questions require answers and the deadline to complete the survey is Tuesday, July 10th. Training dates and locations are TBD.
 - b. Reminder: log in monthly. After 3 consecutive months of not logging in, accounts will be deactivated, and eventually deleted.

 - a. CLPPP is participating in a AMCHP-funded Collaborative Improvement & Innovation Network with several other state CLPPPS. CLPPP has requested further research on two topic areas of 1) recommendation for testing pregnant women and 2) cap to venous testing. AMCHP is conducting research with technical experts, and will be presenting in their findings to us in the future.
