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What is Mi-HHLPSS?

- Web-based application
- Local case managers can:
 - Keep track of patients with elevated blood lead levels
 - Log activities and case notes
 - Look up individual test results
 - Locate previous and current address(es)
 - Attach files to individual cases
- Note: Case managers are only assigned to their local jurisdiction.

Documentation Requirements

- Events

- Home visits

- If there are siblings in the home
 - If education materials were provided

- Contact attempts

- Phone calls
 - Letters
 - Drive by visits
 - Other attempts to contact

- EIs/abatement

- Referral to LSHP
